

Instrument of Government for Gladestry Church in Wales Controlled School



1. SCHOOL

The name of the school is Gladestry Church in Wales Controlled School.

2. CATEGORY OF SCHOOL

The school is a voluntary controlled school.

3. NAME OF GOVERNING BODY

The name of the Governing Body is Gladestry Church in Wales Controlled School Governing Body.

4. COMPOSITION OF GOVERNING BODY

The governing body shall consist of:

- a) 3 parent governors;
- b) 2 LEA governors;
- c) 1 teacher governor;
- d) 0 staff governor;
- e) 2 foundation governors (to be appointed by the Bishop of Swansea and Brecon);

Note:

- i) the incumbent of the parish of New Radnor with Llanfihangel Nant Melan with Evancoyd with Gladestry and Colva shall be a foundation governor ex-officio;
 - ii) the Bishop of Swansea and Brecon shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (i) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor being unable or unwilling to act as foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his governorship exists.
- f) 2 community governors (*1 of who will be appointed by Gladestry Community Council*)
 - g) the headteacher (except at any time when he/she has given written notice to the clerk to the governing body of the school that he/she chooses not to be a governor).

5. TOTAL NUMBER

11 (except any time when the headteacher has given notice that he/she chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be 10).

6. ETHOS STATEMENT

Recognising its historical foundation and in accordance with its Trust Deed, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church in Wales and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve the community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

7. DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION

Subject to regulation 37 of the Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005, this instrument of government comes into effect:

- (i) on the date of making for the purpose of reconstituting the governing body;
- (ii) on 3rd October, 2006 for all other purposes.

This instrument was made by order of Powys Local Education Authority on 3rd October, 2006.
